Bills to create a Federal Department of Peace and Nonviolence (DoP) are currently in committee before the House of Representatives (HR 3760) and the Senate (S.1756). The primary function of the DoP will be to research, articulate and facilitate nonviolent solutions to domestic and international conflict. The DoP will be led by a Cabinet-level Secretary of Peace, and will create and administer The Peace Academy, a sister-organization to current military service academies.
